How to Get your Foam Tested:

Foam Concentrate Test





Step 1: Choose your testing & service level

Contact us to tell us what kind of testing and what level of service you require.

For foam concentrate testing we offer two levels of service:

- Standard Service: 5-working days turnaround from receipt of sample.
- Express Service: 24-hour turnaround from receipt of sample (subject to availability).



Step 2: Collect your sample

For each foam concentrate test sample, we require 1 litre of concentrate.


Samples should be sent in clean, sealed, clearly labelled plastic bottles.



Step 3: Label your sample

To make sure we are testing the correct foam and checking against the relevant parameters, we need certain information to be included on your sample, for example foam type, sample location and foam concentration (%).

Blank labels can be downloaded from our website, and an example can be seen here:





Step 4: Complete a Foam Testing Request Form

To make sure we are carrying out the testing you need, a completed Foam Testing Request Form is required.

A blank template can be downloaded from our website.



Step 5: Print a Safety Data Sheet

Include a copy of the manufacturer's safety data sheet along with your sample, if you have one.

If you don't have an SDS, make sure you include the foam manufacturer's name on your sample. Please note inclusion of an SDS is usually a shipping requirement.

Step 6: Package & Send

Package your labelled sample, Foam Testing Request Form and Safety Data Sheet, if available, in a suitable box or container and send it to us:

Step 7: Testing & Report

On receipt of your sample, we'll get to work testing your foam.

We operate a standard 5-working day turnaround or offer an express 24-hour service (subject to availability): if you're not sure what you need, contact us. Your report will be emailed to you.

To help make sure nothing has been missed for you to have your foam tested, please use the following checklist:

Information needed:

Correct testing selected ie Foam Concentrate, Produced Foam, IMO Foam Concentrate or PFAS TOP Assay testing
Service Level selected ie Standard Service: (5-working days turnaround from receipt of sample) or Express Service (24-hour turnaround from receipt of sample)
Correct amount of foam sample taken For each foam concentrate test sample, we require 1 litre of concentrate
Foam sample correctly labelled including foam type, sample location, foam concentration (%), etc

Foam Testing Request Form completed ensuring all required information is included
